Notes on Using the Weekly Lesson Planner

These are the simple, no muss, no fuss forms I designed for my own use early in our homeschooling. They aren't fancy, but they work!

This version has subjects down the left, so that you can tell at a glance what each student should be doing in each subject.

To record assignments, I use an initial or two for each child, then the text, then the day's assignment. An assignment for Matt in Saxon Math 54 for lesson 8 would look like this: M/S54/8. If I had two children with the same initial, I'd use their middle initial, too, like this: MH/S54/8. Do what works for you, though.

When you have combined subjects (and you should in everything except math and language arts for younger students, I just write ALL instead of a student's initial (or Ygr to signify younger students only) to record the subjects that we are doing together so I don't have to rewrite them for each subject.

I use the final row to record preschool activities, physical activities, field trips, or appointments coming up.
